

## **Freedom of Association**

## Action plan

To build on our human rights strategy, we have committed to publishing an action plan with time-bound measures promoting freedom of association:

- 1. We will include freedom of association as a requirement for suppliers in our code of conduct and sustainable purchasing policy (by end of 2023).
- 2. We will participate in MSIs to support collective bargaining (by end of 2023).
- 3. We will initiate consultations with unions to understand any obstacles to freedom of association, with a special focus on barriers faced by women (by end of 2023).
- 4. We will raise awareness of freedom of association among our suppliers in selected high-risk supply chains (by end of 2024).
- 5. We will implement training on the right of association with a special focus on barriers faced by women for workers in three high-risk supply chains, in consultation with unions and local stakeholders (by end of 2024).
